The end of last year was so encouraging!

It is hard to define the fruit in this ministry. If I were an evangelist it would be easy to count up the 'new life'. Teaching / preaching and sharing is so different and yet I feel God is allowing us to see some of what is happening in peoples lives.

One of my prayers as you will be aware is to see signs and wonders following the preaching of the word and when I look back I see that it has already been happening. In Bydgoszcz earlier in the year and latterly in Kwidzyn the response to the baptism in the Holy was fantasticplus a healing following another preach!
